Rowan has library helper duty during recess today. Rowan's group also meets then to choose slides. Yesterday, Rowan said the slides could wait. Now the group needs one choice before class.

Write the exact sentence Rowan should say.

Rowan must tell the group whether Rowan will ask to switch library duty or let the group choose slides at recess.

- which option Rowan chooses
- when the group should act
- what Rowan will do next

Example: Please choose the slides at recess without me, and I will add pictures after lunch.

Responses will vary. Accept any answer the student can give a practical reason for.

Think about it: Why does naming one clear next step help the group move forward?

TEACHER NOTE

Responses will vary. A strong answer names one clear choice, gives the group a useful time, and explains Rowan's next step. Answers may choose either option if the sentence is clear and easy to act on.

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
