



Missing Pass

DECISION MAKING · WHICH WOULD YOU PICK

Julia is holding the pass-log binder open while two students wait behind her. The study hall aide told everyone to sign the log before leaving. Julia already wrote the destination and time in the next empty row. The laminated hall pass that matches the row is missing from its hook. A student may have taken it without logging out, which is annoying but fixable. Julia needs the library shelf number before study hall ends.

Pick one option and give one practical reason.

- ☐ Tell the study hall aide the matching pass is missing, leave the row started, and ask whether to use a spare pass.
- ☐ Cross out the started row neatly, stay seated, and try the library trip after the pass returns.

Give one practical reason for the choice.

Responses will vary. Accept any answer the student can give a practical reason for.

Think about it: What would make one option easier for the aide to check later?

TEACHER NOTE

Responses will vary. A strong answer identifies that the missing pass is the problem and compares which option is easier to track or more likely to work in time. Other answers are acceptable if Julia follows the pass-log routine and does not leave with an unclear record.

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
