



Friday Finish Check

DECISION MAKING · TWO COLUMNS

Lucia has seven minutes before the bell on Friday. Her class used science cards, sticky notes, and shared bins. The teacher said unfinished work should be easy to find on Monday. Lucia still has one card left to sort.

Sort each action into the column that shows whether it works for Lucia’s Friday close-out.

WORKS	DOESN'T WORK

- 1. Put science cards back in the bin. → Works
- 2. Leave loose sticky notes on the floor. → Doesn't Work
- 3. Clip the unfinished page inside a folder. → Works
- 4. Hide the last card under a book. → Doesn't Work
- 5. Check the shelf for shared supplies. → Works
- 6. Take home the shared bin. → Doesn't Work

Think about it: Why does putting unfinished work in one clear place help on Monday?

TEACHER NOTE

Correct answers: Works: put science cards back in the bin, clip the unfinished page inside a folder, check the shelf for shared supplies. Doesn't Work: leave loose sticky notes on the floor, hide the last card under a book, take home the shared bin. Strong responses connect each choice to finding work later, returning shared items, or leaving the room ready.

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
